SPECIAL RULES FOR YOUTH GOAT SHOW (Read all rules carefully, including General Rules and Information that apply to all exhibitors.)

1. Entries are open to 4-H, FFA, or FHA members who reside in Alabama and neighboring counties in Mississippi and Tennessee. These exhibitors may be enrolled in their first quarter of college; however, if they have been graduated from high school more than one year, they are ineligible to show. Entries are also open to any Alabama youth 3 years old to 18 years old, or no more than 1 year out of high school. Any exhibitor who has not finished elementary or high school and is not actively enrolled in classes is not eligible to show in the Youth Show.
2. Enter at Gate No. 8 and go directly to the Cattle Barn.
3. No bucks or wethers exhibiting testicular tissue will be allowed to show. It is recommended that wethers be banded so no testicular tissue is exhibited.
4. All horned goats must have horns tipped prior to the show.
5. All goats must appear to be in good health. The fair committee will have final say on this matter.
6. All goats must be born after September 15, 2007, and have milk teeth still intact.
7. All goats will be weighed and divided into equal classes: 6 wether and 6 doe classes.
8. Wethers will be judged on their meat or market characteristics.
9. Does will be judged on their breeding and meat or market characteristics.
10. All goats must have identification.
Wether and commercial does must have USDA approved scrape tag.
Registered does must be tattooed and tagged.
11. All goats will be shown with a collar or some type of control device.
12. Due to other programs being previously scheduled, holding pens will not be available at any time prior to, during, or after the show.
13. The decision of the judge will be final.
14. Any exhibitor may show a maximum of 4 wethers and 4 breeding does.
15. Any item not covered under these rules will be decided by the three-member Executive Committee for this show; their decision will be final.
