1. The show shall be governed by the latest revised rules of the ARBA.
2. The North Alabama State Fair will not be responsible for loss in case of fire or theft, accidental or providential destruction.
3. Each entry must have a permanent tattoo on inside left ear.
4. Since this is not a coop show, entries must be transported in a carrying case.
5. Please pre-enter by calling 256-383-8339 before 3 p.m., or 577-2824 after 3 p.m., or by E-mailing zmoinc@aol.com by Wednesday, September 10, 2008, before 10 p.m. DAY OF SHOW entries must be submitted before 1 p.m. on the day of show. Forms will be available when checking in.
6. Entry Fee: \$1.00 per entry.
7. Positively no substitution allowed except in the same breed, class, sex and variety.
8. The show officials reserve the right to substitute another judge in the event the selected one cannot officiate.
